The world will need a major overhaul – **are leaders being prepared?**

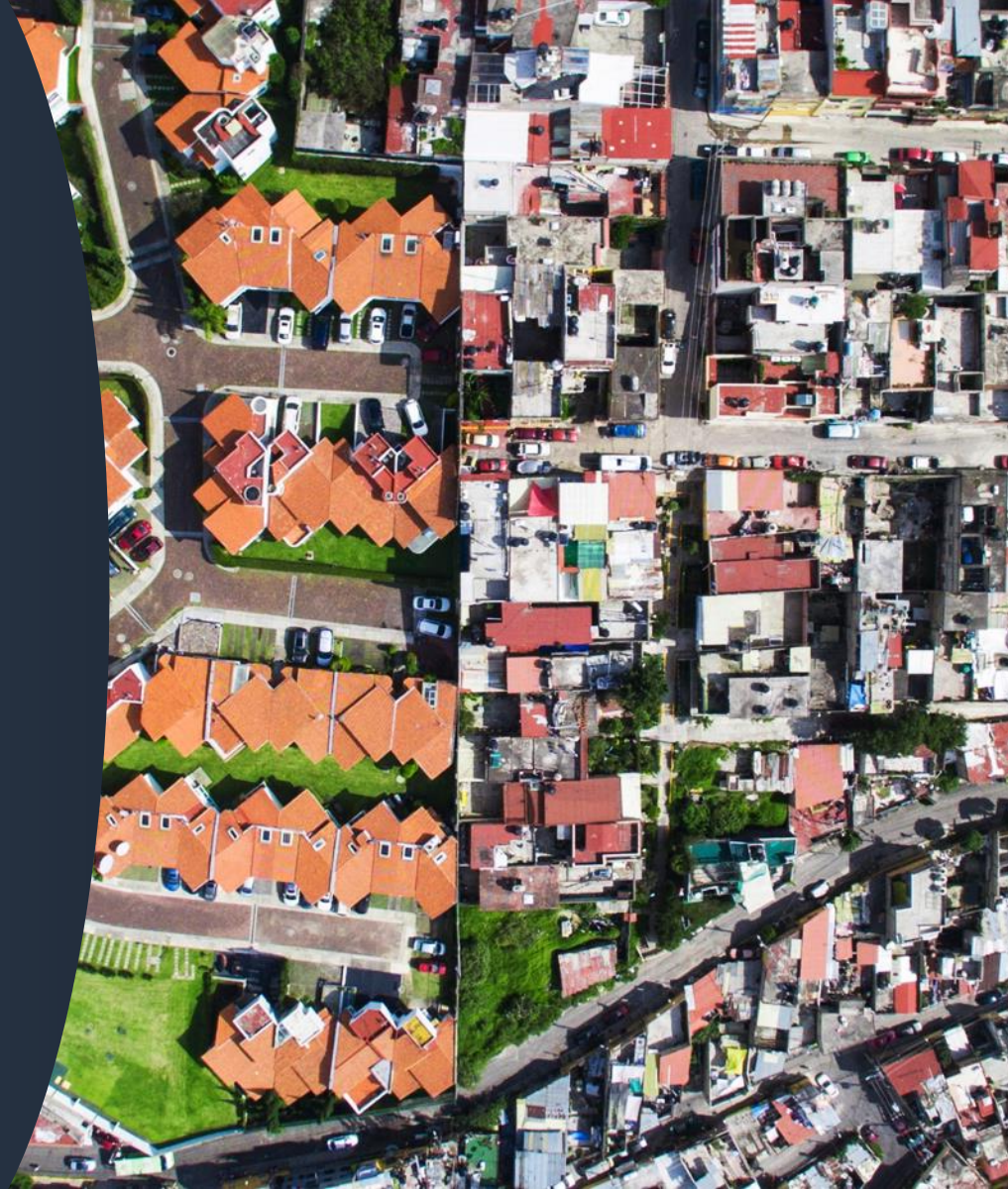

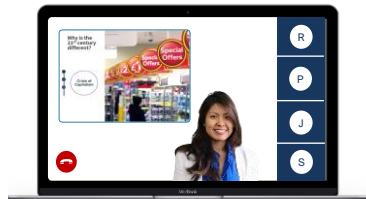
